Key Point: Jesus is the Word of God who speaks grace and truth into our lives.

Life Sharing: (answer one)

- 1. What is a passage of Scripture that you have memorized and why did you memorize it?
- 2. What does the phrase, "You have my word on it" mean and when have you used it in your life?

Transition / Open in prayer:

3. When do you pick up the Bible during an average week? What do you do with it?

Life Examination:

READ John 1:1-14

- 4. What are the 2 or 3 main words in this passage?
- 5. How does Jesus, the Word of God, bring light into the world?
- 6. What was John the Baptist's job? How did he do at that job?
- 7. What does John mean when he says that Jesus "made his dwelling among us"?
- 8. In the stories of Jesus in the New Testament, when do you see Jesus bringing truth? When do you see him bringing grace?

READ Revelation 1:12-18

- 9. List the characteristics of Jesus that John saw. Which one catches your attention today?
- 10. What do the different parts of Jesus' appearance mean to those who would be reading this letter from John?
- 11. Why did John react the way he did?

Life Application:

- 12. Describe a time in your life when you read the Bible and it spoke to you. What was transformational about reading Scripture for you?
- 13. What are some ways people invite Jesus to "dwell" with them, to be an active part of their lives?
- 14. From the Revelation 1 passage, which part of Jesus' appearance would you like to experience this week and why? 15. John the Baptist shared the Word of God (Jesus) with others by preaching in the wilderness. What are some ways we can share the Word of God with others today?
