SIMPLE MESSAGES

SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 28—SIMPLE CHRISTMAS | LOOK — LUKE 2:8-18

When we slow down and focus our attention on the things that matter (faith, family, friendships) we find renewed hope. Hope is confidence in God and what He says about us. The shepherds encounter angels who told them to go look for the One who had been promised. When they found Him they shared the message of hope. Looking for God in our world still produces hope. "Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see." —Hebrews 11:1

SUNDAY, DECEMBER 5—SIMPLE CHRISTMAS | LESS—LUKE 1:67-80

Have you ever thought about how having more stuff often causes more stress? You could almost say stuff = stress. John the Baptist came to guide people toward peace and he did it in a very unique way. Living a simple life, that some would call extreme, he was able to speak in a new way and help people see that God was breaking through. When Jesus came, John said, "I must become less" (John 3:30). What does it mean to "become less" in our lives today?

SUNDAY, DECEMBER 12—SIMPLE CHRISTMAS | LISTEN—LUKE 1:46-56

Mary sang a song to express her joy at the news of Jesus. God spoke to her about what He would do and Mary listened. Her first reaction was "greatly troubled," but she moved to joy as she listened to the angel and to her cousin Elizabeth. Do you hear what God is saying into your life today?

SUNDAY, DECEMBER 19—SIMPLE CHRISTMAS | LIGHT—MATTHEW 4:12-19

Jesus fulfilled the prophecy of Isaiah "the people living in darkness have seen a great light" (Isaiah 9:2). The opposite of light is darkness but it is also heavy. When we love others we lift the burdens they carry and help them see a new way with God. To repent means to let go of our heavy burdens and embrace the love of God.

THURSDAY, DECEMBER 23 & FRIDAY, DECEMBER 24—SIMPLE CHRISTMAS | LIFE—LUKE 2:1-7

Simple can be defined as humble, common, and easy to understand. That is how God chose to enter into our lives, as a baby. His humbleness calls us to live in a different way, as those who give the gift of our lives to others. We give ourselves away so that others can find life.
