



*even to those who believe in His name.*" John 1:12


GOD THE SON

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. If you really know me, you will know my Father as well." John 14:6-7




Learning about God creates FAITH in Him.

He has told us Who He is and what He is like in the BIBLE.


What God teaches us about Himself are called

**GOD IS...**

Infinite - impossible to measure, boundless, unlimited, never-ending



“Great is our Lord and mighty in power; His understanding has NO LIMITS.”

Psalm 147:5



It is impossible for the limited mind to grasp the Unlimited.  
Our minds are limited. He is greater than our thoughts.  
He is greater than language.

God is without measure.

We use words like weight, distance, and length to measure created things like mountains, gravity, stars, liquid, energy, sound, light...

But none of these ways to measure apply to God.

It is impossible to measure God because He has no limits.

Because God's nature is LIMITLESS everything that flows out of Him is LIMITLESS!


His Provision is LIMITLESS

His Love is LIMITLESS


"As the Father has loved Me, so have I loved you. Now remain (abide) in My love."

**TALK TO GOD**

Using the ARK model:

A: Agree

R: Revelation

K: Keep

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. If you really know me, you will know my Father as well." John 14:6-7

A: LORD, I agree with You. Jesus, You are the ONLY way to the Father. When I know You, I know Father God.

R: Show me more about what You mean that You are the way. Give me a deeper understanding of You as the truth. Help me to know what it means that You are the life.

K: Holy Spirit, help me to know You and love You more. Help me to trust You and obey You more. Help me to believe that when I know Jesus, I also know His Father. Thank You, Jesus, for providing the way, the truth, and the life to the Father. Amen
