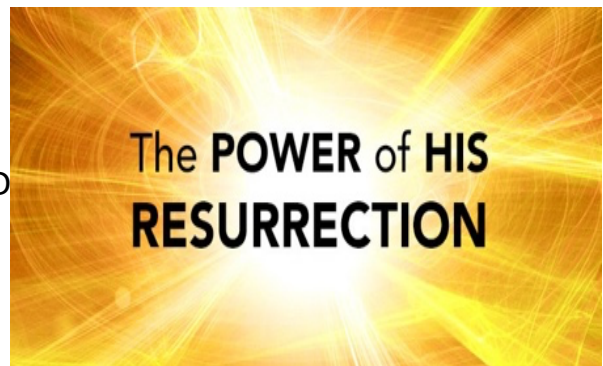

JESUS CHOSE THE CROSS BECAUSE HE **LOVES** US!

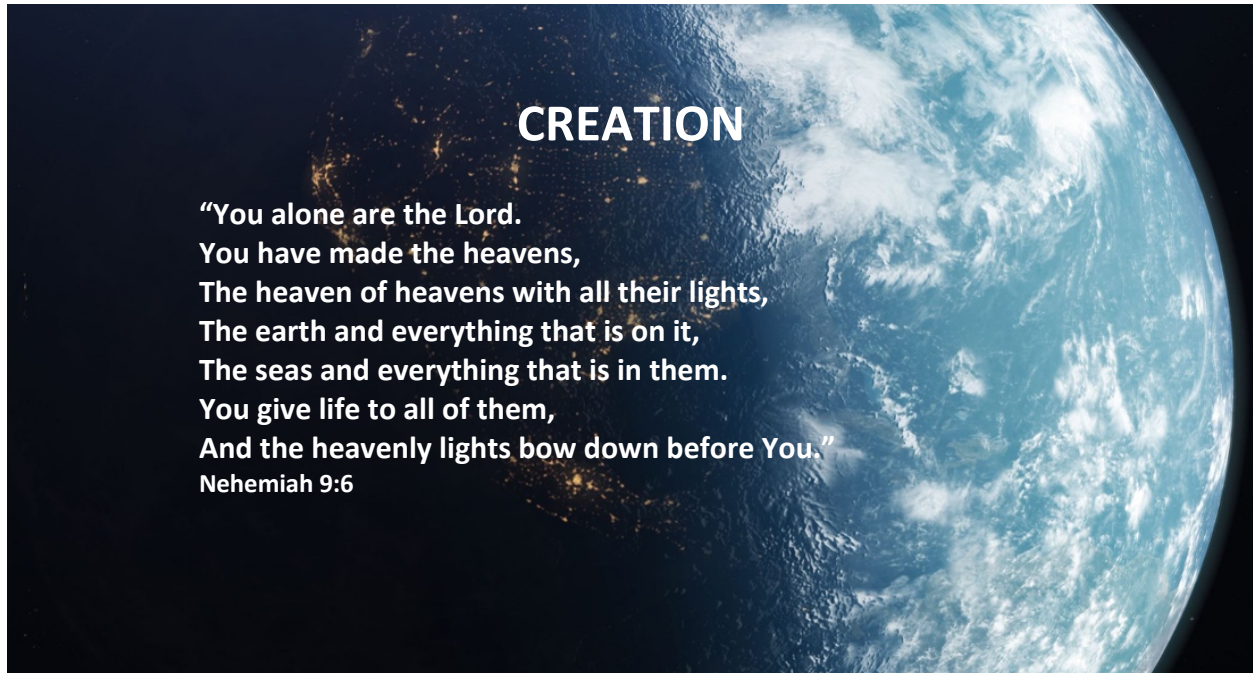
AND

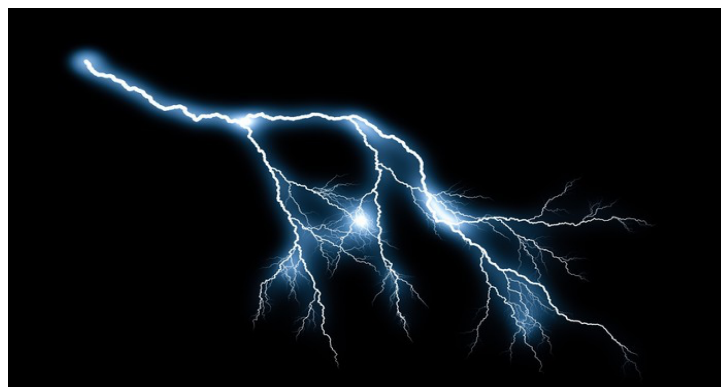

Genesis 1:3

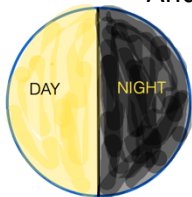
And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light.

Where did the light come from?

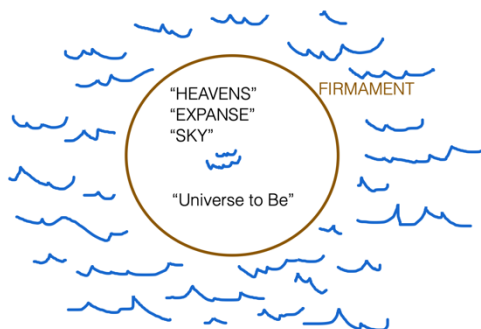
# DAY 2

Number of stars in the known universe:

- DISCOVERED (at least) =  $2^{22}$  STARS \*20,000,000,000,000,000,000\*
- MATHEMATICAL PROJECTION =  $4^{23}$  STARS \*400,000,000,000,000,000,000\*
