

THE FIRST "I AM" Exodus 3:14-15

God said to Moses, **"I am who I am.** This is what you are to say to the Israelites: **'I am** has sent me to you.'"

God also said to Moses, "Say to the Israelites, 'The Lord, the God of your fathers—the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob—has sent me to you.'

"This is my name forever, the name you shall call me from generation to generation."


This is the first time in the Bible when God calls Himself, "I AM"

John 6:35



What Do You Think Sheep Have To Do With Jesus?

Let's use our detective skills and see if we can figure this mystery out!

What do you know about sheep?

What do they eat?
What does a sheep feel like?
Where do sheep live?
What sound do sheep make?
What is a baby sheep called?
What color are sheep?
What do we use sheep for?



Why do you think sheep are in the Bible?

Here are some clues:

For He is our God and we are the people of His pasture the flock under His care. Psalm 95:7

Know that the Lord is God. It is He who made us, and we are His; we are His people, the sheep of His pasture. Psalm 100:3

Who takes care of sheep?

Shepherds take care of sheep.
I think we may have discovered part of our mystery here.
Let's dive deeper to find out more...

The Good Shepherd and His Sheep



Read this Scripture passage in your Bible: JOHN 10:1-14



Here's the Story from the Gospel of John Chapter 10: (Jesus' Words Are In Red)

"Very truly I tell you Pharisees...."

Hold up! That's a big word! What is a Pharisee?

A Pharisee was a person who was in charge of making the religious laws and teaching people. But they often didn't teach people the right things. Jesus was becoming frustrated with them. Let's continue.

".... Anyone who does not enter the sheep pen by the gate, but climbs in by some other way, is a thief and a robber."

Yikes! I don't want to be a thief, do you? We better read on and see the right way to enter!

"The one who enters by the gate is the shepherd of the sheep. The gatekeeper opens the gate for him, and the sheep know his voice. He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out."

This scripture is telling us that Jesus knows each one of us! He knows EVERYONE'S name! Isn't that crazy? He knows my name, and **He knows your name!**

"....he goes ahead of them, and his sheep follow him because they know his voice."

And it says that He will lead us. When we aren't sure what to do, we can pray and ask Jesus to help us. He will show us the way! No matter what the situation, He goes ahead of us and will lead the way!

"I AM the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved. They will come in and go out, and find pasture. The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy;

I have come that they may have life and have it to the full."

Stop and think about it: What do you think Jesus is saying here?

He is saying that He will always protect us. He will make sure that we are safe wherever we go, and He will make sure that we have a life that is full of joy and hope in Him. That sounds pretty great to me! There's even more:

"I AM the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.

The hired hand is not the shepherd and does not own the sheep.

So when he sees the wolf coming he abandons the sheep and runs away.

Then the wolf attacks the flock and scatters it. The man runs away because he is a hired hand and cares nothing for the sheep.

I AM the good shepherd: I know my sheep and my sheep know me."

Jesus is telling us here that only He can protect us. If we put our trust in anyone else, they will fail. Only Jesus is the one that can truly protect us!

Think About It:

If your friend asked you what it means that Jesus is your shepherd, what would you tell them?

Sheep are often scared of wolves. What are some things that you are afraid of?

When you are afraid of something, what can you do to help you conquer that fear?

BIG IDEA:

Jesus is the Gate for the Sheep

Shepherds protect their sheep from predators.

When I follow Jesus, He protects me when I am scared.

He helps me know where to go to stay safe.

He helps me to make wise choices that will keep me out of trouble and keep me secure.

Use the ARK model (A: Agree R: Revelation K: Keep) to pray using Scripture.


Therefore Jesus said again, "Very truly I tell you, I am the gate for the sheep.
