

### Solomon's Dream

I Kings 3:5-15

King Solomon had a dream where God asked him,
"Solomon, ask for whatever you want, and I will give it to you."

King Solomon asked for wisdom to rule over the people of Israel.

God was pleased with his answer, so He decided to give him wisdom and wealth and honor — "so that in your lifetime you will have no equal among kings."

Two mothers with one baby came before King Solomon claiming to be the baby's mom. The king used his God-given wisdom to discover who the REAL mom was.




The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction. Proverbs 1:7

King Solomon Is Also Famous for Building God's First Temple

| Kings 6
| Facts About the Temple:

### It took 7 years to build.

The outside walls were made of stones hewn at the quarry and brought to the building site.

There were no hammers, axes, or iron tools heard in the temple while it was being built.

There were 3,300 foremen to manage construction.

Inside the temple, no stone was to be seen.

It had cedar walls that were overlaid with gold.

It was decorated with carvings of gold covered flowers.

There were 2 gold covered angels that were 15 feet high each with a wingspan of 15 feet. They used 34 tons of gold throughout the temple which today would cost about \$2 BILLION! The total cost of the temple today would be about \$5-6 BILLION

### The Ark of the Covenant Was Brought into the Temple | Kings 8:1-11




The Ark of the Covenant with the Mercy Seat reminded Israel of their need for salvation in God.

### **The Temple is Dedicated**

I Kings 8:12-65

The dedication ceremony offering consisted of 22,000 oxen and 120,000 sheep. The dedication feast lasted 14 days!

As followers of Jesus, we read in the New Testament:

### 1 Corinthians 6:19-20

"Do you not know that **your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit**, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your bodies."

### Because God Is Wise, He Leads Me into Wisdom

The wisdom that God gave Solomon is the same wisdom that He wants to give you. When you follow Jesus, the Holy Spirit is in you. He wants to lead you in wisdom so you can remain close to God. Honor Him by asking Him for His wisdom. He will give you His wisdom as you trust Him for it.




### My Response:

**Reveal**– Please show me how to follow You. Show me how I can honor You better. Show me how to stay away from evil and be led by Your wisdom.






