

Hillcrest Preschool Families,

We are excited to welcome everyone to the 2022-2023 school year. School will begin on September 6th. All paperwork must be turned in to me before families can begin. New families will need to have turned in the following forms: enrollment form, emergency medical, health assessment, immunizations, and child form. These forms were included in your enrollment packet. They can also be found on our website, hillcrestcov.org, under weekday preschool. Returning families to Hillcrest will need the following forms on file before a child can begin, enrollment form and updated immunizations. If your child has a food allergy or medical condition, I will be reaching out to develop an emergency plan. If there is a food allergy in your child's classroom, that food allergy will be posted outside of the classroom.

Students are not required to wear face masks at school. If you are more comfortable with your child wearing a face mask, that is ok. Teachers will not be wearing face masks. Students will arrive and be accompanied by staff to their classrooms at the beginning of the day. Parents are invited to pick up their child at the end of the day at their classroom.

We will have "Meet the Teacher Day" on **August 31st and September 1st**. This is a time to visit your child's classroom and meet their teachers. Students will stay in their classrooms and I will invite you to a meeting in Fellowship Hall.
