the name you shall call me


from generation to generation."

John 10:11




Jesus Is Committed To Caring And Watching Over Those Who Are His.

Jesus Is The Source Of All Truth And Knowledge About God.

This lesson we hear Jesus say,

"I AM the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in Me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from Me you can do nothing."

John 15:5



Grapes Grow In A Unique Way Do you know how they grow?

They grow on a vine! Once they are removed from the vine, they start to die, they get all squishy, and eventually they dry up. But if they are still connected to the vine, they can get the nutrients through the vine that they need to survive!

Jesus Tells Us That He Is Like Our "Vine."

BY ATTACHING OURSELVES TO CHRIST, WE BECOME LIKE HIM AND BEAR GOOD FRUIT THAT WILL HONOR GOD.

Did You Ever Think Of Yourself As A Grape?

Does That All That Sounds A Little Crazy And Confusing?

Let's learn some more about what Jesus means when He says He is the Vine and we are the branches..



Do You Remember Which Book Of The Bible We Have Been Studying? To Hear Jesus Saying: "I AM the Bread of Life", I AM the Light of the World", "I AM the Gate for the sheep", "I AM the Good Shepherd", "I AM the Way, the Truth, and the Life."

We find all these Scriptures in the **Gospel of John.**

- Today's: "I AM the Vine", is also in the book of John. Let's look up John 15:5
- Grab your Bible.
 - o Find the New Testament.
 - o The book of John is last of the 4 Gospels.
 - The order is: Mathew, Mark, Luke then John.
- Find the book of John. (Remember, you can use your table of contents in the beginning of your Bible if you need to.)
 - o Find John chapter 15 (use the big numbers) then
 - Find verse 5 (use the small numbers).

Read John 15:5 in your Bible. It will sound like this:

"I AM the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in Me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from Me you can do nothing."

Based On What We Have Learned So Far, What Do You Think This Scripture Means? What Is Jesus Telling Us About Himself And About Us?

Jesus is telling us that when we live our life with Him, we can live lives that are fruitful. Just like when the grapes are removed from the vine, they start to die. They get all squishy, and eventually dry up. If we choose to live apart from Jesus, we will be like a squishy, dried-up grape and not have a life that is fruitful.

What Does It Mean To Live A Fruitful Life?

Living a fruitful life happens by letting God love us and loving Him back. As we follow Jesus and obey Him, this helps others to know about His greatness, goodness, and love. When we are attached to Him, He helps us to show kindness and love to others. When we are following Jesus, it is much easier to be kind and patient with others. It is also easier to be kind and patient with ourselves!

Do You Ever Get Frustrated With Yourself About Something? Maybe Something That You Struggle To Do Or Aren't Good At?

God wants us to be kind, patient, and helpful to others. But...

He Also Wants Us To Be Kind And Patient With Ourselves.

God made each of us special, just the way that He wanted us. His creation of us is perfect to Him! He loves us all the time, even when we are learning, growing, and making mistakes. No matter how many mistakes we make, when we ask Him to forgive us, the Holy Spirit will help us and release the fruit of His Spirit through us.

"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control." Galatians 5:22-23a




Let's Look At Some Situations Where People Can Bear Good Fruit With Jesus' Help.



Ella's big brother is in a bad mood. He had a really bad day at football practice. Ella asked him if he wanted to play a game, and he snapped back at her and told her to leave him alone. Ella has two choices here. She can yell back at him and get angry at him, or she can be fruitful like Jesus. What Are Some Ways That Ella Could Choose To Be Fruitful?

Abby's mom accidentally forgot to get her favorite snack at the grocery store. Abby had asked her specifically to get that snack for her before she went to the store that morning. Abby is really frustrated that her mom forgot. Abby has two choices here. She can choose to get angry and whine, or she can choose to be fruitful like Jesus.

What Are Some Ways That Abby Could Choose To Be Fruitful?





Sam's friend accidentally kicked his favorite ball over the fence. It rolled down the street, and into the storm drain. Sam knew there was no way he was going to get it back. Sam has two choices here. He can get mad at his friend and tell him to go home, or he can choose to be fruitful like Jesus.

What are some ways that Sam could choose to be fruitful?

What do you think Jesus means when He says: "If you remain in Me and I in you..."?

Some Ways To "Remain In Jesus"

- Trust Jesus As Your Savior
- Worship & Thank God
- Pray & Let Him Help You

- Read His Bible and Obey His Word
- Think About Your Actions
- Make Wise Choices

As we do these things, it gets easier and easier to be like Jesus.

This is how we stay "attached to the vine."

Do You Have A Person In Your Life That You Really Like To Be Around Because They Are Kind And Make You Feel Loved?

You can be that person for others! When you attach yourself to Jesus, just like the branch is attached to the vine so the fruit stays good; you will become more like Jesus every day.

As Jesus makes you feel loved and special, His love and kindness will squish out of you (just like sweet, yummy grape juice) and you will help make others feel loved and special too!

Is there a way that you could have handled it better?

What are some ways that we can work to stay connected to Jesus so that we can be fruitful?

Remember:


Jesus Said,




Reveal– Please show me more about what it means that You are the True Vine. Teach me how to remain in You every day of my life. Show me how much I depend on You for EVERYTHING!




